

# AGREEMENT FOR RESEARCH USE OF DATA

THIS AGREEMENT is made the \_\_\_\_\_ Day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2003

BETWEEN

Oxford University Press (‘the Publisher’) at Great Clarendon Street, Oxford, OX2 6DP

AND

**[INSERT NAME]** (‘the Research Team’) at **[INSERT ADDRESS & AFFILIATION]**

WHEREAS the Publisher possesses confidential information and expertise in the creation of dictionaries and the Research Team wishes to undertake non-commercial academic research on the Publisher’s materials, the Publisher has agreed to supply the Research Team with the Full Text of the **[INSERT TITLE/S]** in machine-readable form (hereinafter called ‘the Text’).

## Definitions

“Associated Materials” means any texts, statistics and other materials resulting from the Assessment, Research Work and/or Development Work undertaken on the Text by the Research Team.

“Assessment” means any assessment and/or checking work undertaken on the Text by the Research Team.

“Commercial Use” means any use of the Text and/or Associated Materials which results in commercial gain by any party.

“Development Work” means any work undertaken using the Text which works towards development of systems, products or services.

“Research Work” means any research work undertaken on the Text by the Research Team.

IN CONSIDERATION of the Publisher agreeing to the Text being supplied to the Research Team, the Research Team hereby undertakes:

1. To use the Text for purposes of Assessment, Research Work, Development Work and the production of Associated Materials only and not for profit. Any use of the Text for purposes other than the preceding, or any Commercial Use of the Text or Associated Materials will be subject to a separate agreement to be negotiated between the Publisher and the Research Team at a later date.
2. To accept that any work undertaken by the Research Team as part of the activities in Clause 1 above is at the Research Team’s expense and risk.
3. To acknowledge that copyright in all machine-readable texts issued by the Publisher is reserved.
4. Not to copy in whole or in part the Text, except insofar as this may be necessary for security purposes or for the Research Team's activities as listed in Clause 1 above.

5. Not to distribute the Text or Associated Materials to third parties, nor to publish or reproduce it in any way except for illustrative examples in research reports and similar.
6. To give access to the Text and Associated Materials only to persons working directly with the Research Team and to require of such persons signed undertakings neither to use the Text and Associated Materials except in connection with the Research Team's activities as listed in Clause 1 above, nor to copy or make available the Text or Associated Materials to others; these signed undertakings to be made available to the Publisher on request.
7. Not to hold the Publisher liable for any errors of transcription which may be found in the Text, but to notify the Publisher of such errors wherever possible.
8. To cite the Publisher in full in any publications or otherwise available materials concerning the Text and/or the Research Team's Assessment, Research Work, Development Work or the Associated Materials.
9. To supply to the Publisher annual reports due each 12 months after signature of this Agreement detailing the Research Team's Assessment, Research Work, Development Work, the Associated Materials, and any other pertinent information (max. 4 pages). If requested by the Publisher, to provide more details of use of the Text and the Associated Materials.

The Publisher:

10. Will supply the Research Team with an electronic copy of the Text as soon as practicable following signature of this Agreement.
11. Agrees not to disclose without prior agreement with the Research Team to any third party any details of the Research Team's Assessment, Research Work, Development Work and Associated Materials, nor will it disclose in similar fashion any details of the Research Team's business and product plans, nor its business contacts, partners or customers, except insofar as these details are publicly available.
12. Acknowledges that the copyright of any material supplied back to the Publisher relating to this Agreement or the research work undertaken by the Research Team shall be held in joint copyright between the Publisher and the Research Team.
13. Undertakes to distribute or permit distribution at no or low cost Additional Materials as produced by the Research Team and supplied to the Publisher for this purpose, on the following conditions:
  - 13.1 if the material is in the opinion of the Publisher of sufficient quality
  - 13.2 if copyright is assigned to Publisher by the Research Team

This Agreement terminates three years after date of signature and all material supplied must be returned or destroyed as instructed by the Publisher.

Should the Research Team breach the terms of this agreement in any way then the Research Team undertakes to return or destroy (at the Publisher's option) the Text and all related material supplied by the Publisher and will cease to use the Publisher's confidential material thereafter, and will compensate the Publisher for any loss of revenues, damage to reputation or any other injury.
